

**Color-Country
Animal Welfare**

With Spring just around the corner, Color-Country Animal Welfare is asking for everyone's help to prevent unwanted litters of kittens. Low cost vouchers for spaying and neutering are available as well as help with trapping community (feral) cats. We have also recently developed a Barn Cat Program, where community cats that have been sterilized and vaccinated for rabies and a number of other common diseases are relocated to barns to help with rodent control.

Last year through our TNR (Trap Neuter Return) program, 149 cats were spayed and neutered. We are continuing to work hard to get the cat population under control in our county but we need your help. If you have cats yourself, know of cats that need to be spayed or neutered, or are interested in participating in the Barn Cat Program, please contact John Benson at 425-3636.
