Planning and Zoning Report. Darrell Mansell He reported on the progress of the annexation.

The lawyer will tell the council when we can go forward with the annexation. He is working with the other lawyer to resolve another problem. A copy of the new annexation policy will be sent to the office and a copy will be given to the planning and Zoning committee.

Council member Pat Kearney would like to be informed as the case progresses. As soon as we receive information we will forward it to the councilmembers via email.

Maintainance. The sod for the Big Apple is going forward. It will be here the next week. If the

sod arrives in time it will be laid before the 4th other wise we will wait until after to avoid it being trampled on. Chad asked if the council had any projects for him. Council member Doug Robinson asked that the cemetery project be put on the project list and a fence be built to hide the unsightly view on the new addition that is not developed.

Councilmember Dustin asked if Chad had been able to get any prices for chip and seal. Pat would like the pot holes by culvert at the entrance of 100 East.
