**Welcome:** Mayor Adus welcomed the people and called the meeting of March 14, 2013 to order at 6:00 pm. Mayor Dorsey stated that this meeting was the regular monthly meeting. A motion was made by Council member Jen Howe to accept the February 13, 2013 minutes as read and corrected. It was seconded by Ty Markham. All council members voted in favor.

**Financial Report:** Treasurer Colleen Dudleston gave the financial report for the preceding month. She went over the cash summary for all Bank Accounts as of 22/28/2013.

Colleen also gave each council member an update on their department budgets.

We have used 75% of the fiscal year budget. There are three more months left in the fiscal year and Colleen indicated what percent of the budget was left and we are doing well and should be able to handle the next three months.

Colleen then went over the Water company budget. Several questions were asked as to why some of the payments were higher and she indicated that the insurance premiums had gone up and also the forest service permits went up. There were questions on fuel expense and Colleen explained it was because we filled the tank and it would not be a monthly expense. Also we had two flash floods and the repair work cost was high but that money came from the rainy day fund.

**Park Janet Hansen.** People are starting to come to the park now that the weather is getting warmer. The volleyball court is seeing some use. Janet said we needed more chips under the swings and climbing wall. Chad was going to check with Bruce Chappell to see if we could get some from him. The bids came back for a glass front and door on the south side of the pavilion. The bid was close to \$3000.00 and it was decided we could not do that at this time. Janet would get a bid to get new windows for the pavilion. The town has been awarded \$1000.00 in grant money to plant trees in the town. This will take place at our Arbor Day celebration on Friday May 3<sup>rd</sup>. Ross Chambless will also give a demonstration on how to plant trees. We will need a lot of volunteers that day and Janet would like all the council members to help also. The volunteers help with the matching grant from Tree Utah. Chad has been working on preparing the sites for the trees. The pavilion needs to be cleaned so any help there would be appreciated.

A light lunch will be served. Reservations are being made for summer reunions and the pavilion will need a cleanup.

Janet Hansen and Sheri Clark are working on the Apple Days Race. The prize this year is a Mini iPad. Hopefully we will sell many tickets.

Janet has been working to get sponsors for the RED ROCK RACE 5k/10k race to be held on July 27<sup>th</sup>

**Roads/Water Curtis Cook.** Curtis said the water project is coming along and Jacksons have some work left and will resume working on March 18, 2013.

**Cemetery Jennifer Howe.** Jen said she will begin working on the old cemetery clean up.

**Planning and Zoning Ty Markham.** A Planning and Zoning meeting will be held on the 19<sup>th</sup> of March at 7 pm at the town Hall. At this time a Chair person and secretary will be selected. All people who were asked to serve as members seem to be excited to be a part of the committee.

### **Mayor Report.**

The Water project is coming along. Because we have some surplus money and we will be able to continue to work on the line. Hydrants have been placed on Sandcreek road and the valves will be placed in town. The water problem by the Catholic Church has been fixed.

**Tour Utah Bike Race.** Mayor Adus Dorsey gave an update on the bike race that will be coming to Torrey in August. Scott Anderson will be in charge of volunteers and Stewart Talley from Red River Ranch will also help with the race as it comes to Torrey. Councilmember Jen Howe asked just what the town was required to do. The Mayor said Nicole Durfey of the Travel Council will contact the hotels as we are in need in 105 rooms. Mayor said the town will not have to pay for the rooms, it will come from donations and funding he has found. Janet asked the Mayor asked about the use of the Randy Austin's property for vendors and hospitality tent. There were questions about the porta potties and the wash stands that would be needed. Questions were also asked about security, and the Mayor said the county would handle that. Scott Anderson said the tour would get all permits necessary. Any funds that come in will be send to Nycole and the travel council. The County has committed to give money and resources to the town and provide the services for the race. Scott Anderson said he would offer the sponsorship of his bike race to help with the costs of the race. Councilmember Janet Hansen asked if we are responsible for the meals, Mayor said no. Caters will be responsible for meals and table and chairs. Scott Anderson said CRC (his bike race) has a ton of stuff that would be available to the town for racing He also said the Bike tour would bring their own expo with them and the vendors would bring their own tents. The town will be responsible for the nine floral arrangements to be awarded to the winners and a prize that is representative of the town. The Tour also brings, puts up and takes down all the signage. Janet asked the question how could the council help and the Mayor said as soon as he had more answers he would tell the council. The biggest job for Torrey will be to do good PR work. The race will be exciting and inviting to all people and we need to encourage all to come and be a part of it. The rooms and vendor lots will be firmed up by next week. Scott Anderson complemented the Mayor on the work he has done so far on the Bike Race. Janet asked what the council could do to help. The Mayor said he has spoken to several people and groups to help with the race.

Janet Hansen made the motion to send Colleen to Pelorus training on March 29, in Provo. Jen Howe seconded the motion.

Torrey Town cleanup will be all of the month of May. Dumpsters will be here on May 20, 21<sup>st</sup>. and possibly the 22<sup>nd</sup>.

Colleen gave an update on Big Apple Days Information. A meeting will be held on March 19<sup>th</sup> at 6 in the Town Hall. Leslie Oyler has agreed to chair the Event. Several new events will hopefully be added and people are excited to work on the event.

A motion adjourn was made by councilmember Jennifer Howe and seconded by Janet Hansen and all were in favor. The meeting adjourned at 7:12
