Council Members Present

A special meeting was held by the town council members to elect a Mayor pro temp. Clerk Paula Pace explained that the Mayor and mayor pro temp had resigned and it was necessary to elect a mayor pro temp to conduct the town council meeting. She also explained the process for getting a new mayor and council member. Council member Ty Markham was selected as the Mayor pro temp by Pat Kearney Seconded by Dustin Oyler. .
Roll call vote Dustin Oyler, yay, Pat Kearney Yay, Ty Markham yay.

After the selection of Ty Markham, the regular scheduled council meeting was called to order.

Welcome: Mayor pro temp Ty Markham welcomed the people and called the meeting March 20, 2014 to order at 6:07 pm. **Administrative Business**

Mayor called for motion to accept the minutes of the February Meeting.

Motion: To accept the minutes of regular meeting held February 13, 2014.

All council members voted in favor. Motion carried.

Financial clerk Colleen Duddelston was absent and the financial report will be given next month.

Maintenance Report. Chad Williams The water project is up and running again with the installation of the chlorination station. There will be a flush of the lines and a date will be posted as to when that will happen. Chad reported that there will be a sanitary survey this year. At this time the town water system is checked out from the springs on down for any problems. They check the valves, tank, and lines to make sure the system is working up to par.

Chad asked if any springtime projects need to be addressed to please let him know. The town's seasonal help will be coming on mid- April. Josh will be the help again this year. The dumpster will be here Thursday the 30th of April to 5th of May. Wayne County is not furnishing free day to the towns. It will cost the town \$100.00 a dump, 8 dollars a ton and 2 dollars per day rental. The date will be posted on the bulletin board as well as the web site. Mayor Markham posed the question if the town could provide help to those who need some help removing items from their yards. It was suggested that the poster ask for volunteers to help, and if a person needed

help with removal of items they should notify the town.

Chad has looked to the cost of sod and sprinkler system for the Big Apple. The cost for the two would be approximately \$2000.00. The money would come from the cemetery and park fund and would not be a hardship for the town. The suggestion was made to look into some alternative grass types that may use less water.

The council approved the rental of 20 of the town's Sand Creek water shares. They will lease for \$50.00 a share. A person must own at least one share to rent a share.

Chad explained the remodel of the office. The money had already been approved in this year's budget. The council felt like since they were a new council, they would like to see three new fresh bids.

No permits.

Website update. Pat has worked with Whitney on the Website. E-mail Pat if you have any event you would like on the calendar. Letters have been sent to the businesses with a form for them to fill out if they would like to be linked to our website.

Tour of Utah Nycole Durfey. The tour has received from county money to help with the Tour. An asphalt stamp for Tour of Utah will be placed across the road stating that Torrey is the official finish line of stage 2.

Nycole asked the town for permission to put up banners for Tour of Utah. It will be on no cost to the town. \$17,000.00 from County.

A motion was made by Ty to give permission to hang the banners and it was seconded by Pat Kearney Motion carried.

It was also asked if yard signs could be placed along the road sided sometime in mid-July. The council would like to see the signs before deciding, and would like only a few placed around town.

The question was asked how much revenue is generated from the Tour of Utah. Nycole said that could not be determined yet as it needs to be tracked. Most revenue will be generated by people returning back to the Torrey area. The Media value is the thing that helps Torrey the most.

Tour of Utah is advertising for a caterer for the VIP Tent. There will also be vendors in the Big Apple.

Sponsorships packages available will be available to businesses.

Nycole would like the gift for the winner to come from local craftsmen and she encouraged all

to be thinking about it and make any suggestions. Someone from the board needs to be a liaison for Tour of Utah. Many volunteers are needed for the Tour of Utah and Nycole would like people to call her office if anyone is interested. Her phone is 425-3930. Need help for all the events for so please get in touch with Nycole Potter. There will be planned activities kids as well as older people. Nycole said the advertising will be done on the website and later there will be ads in the Insider.

Council reports: Parks and Trees. Pat Kearney gave a report previously in the meeting regarding clean up and tree planting. No report on cemetery or roads.

Big Apple Days. Report was given by Paula Pace. A meeting was held on March 11th and the biggest change this year all events and vendors will be at the park. Most all events will be the same with a few minor changes.

Planning and Zoning Report. Darrel Mansell. The planning and zoning is still working on the sign ordinance. Building ordinance is being looked and he would like some input from the council as to what kind of ideas should go into the building ordinance.

Some of the council members did not get the revised sign ordinance and so no vote was taken on the sign ordinance, and the council will be prepared to vote at the April meeting.

Darrel said that the perhaps the planning and zoning may be able get a grant for the town for professional planners to help with our general plan. However, Torrey probably could not come up with their part of the money.

The general consensus of the council was to keep setting goals and keep moving forward to help improve the town.

He said Mr. Chamberlain was here earlier and gave the town some ideas as to what they had to do to continue with the annexation.
