Welcome: Mayor Adus Dorsey welcomed the people and called the meeting of October 11, 2012 to order at 6:00 pm. Mayor Dorsey stated that this meeting was the regular monthly meeting. A motion was made by Janet Hansen to accept the minutes of the September 18, 2012 meeting as read and seconded by Curtis Cook. All council members voted in favor. Mayor reported two council members were out of town.

Financial report. Colleen said the money for the water project had been placed into the PTIF account and it is now opened and two reimbursements have been made; one payment for 129 thousand, and one for 220 thousand. Each member was given an account of his department. Colleen explained how the class C road money is being spent and was going to give Curtis an update on his monies. The Mayor asked the chart on the water use be posted on the post office bulletin board.

Council Reports

Parks Janet Hansen: Bruce Vandyke will be putting Formica on the long serving table in the pavilion. He quoted the price of \$300.00; this money will come from the park budget. Janet has asked that Chad oil the other wooden tables this winter. The light for the Flag display will be here tomorrow. The display will consist of the United State Flag, a State Flag, a County Flag and the Tree City Flag; these will be displayed at the Big Apple on special occasions. A bid of \$20.00 for the old park picnic table was accepted; two tables will sold. The Mayor said he would by one also.

Janet received word from Meredith Perkins of the State Natural Resources that the town has received a grant for \$8000.00 to help trim the main street trees. The town will match the money.

The town will need 3 bids from certified arborists. Chad and Janet have contacted several and we have two bids. One is from Seven Trees, a company from Spanish Fork, and Tree Top of Wellington. A tree service from LaVerkin has also inquired. Janet said we will need permits from UDOT to work on the road. The question was asked if we may need a flagger. The Mayor said the traffic may have to be rerouted during this time. The estimated start time is November 1st. We will be cutting the bigger pieces into smaller pieces for those volunteers who would like to haul if off for firewood. Janet thanked the office for their help in preparing the grant.

Roads Curtis Cook. There are some of the roads in town that need repair from the work on the water project. He also noted that 3rd North needs to be paved and Janet suggested that some gravel be placed on the road on at 150 east. There was a leak in the line down by Nancy Sinclair's, but has been repaired. The walls have been poured for the water tank up in the sleeping Rainbow Estates.

Mayor Report

The Mayor would like to have some names presented to the council for the Planning and Zoning committee as soon as possible.

Mayor asked if he could attend the Utah Land Use conference on the 23 and 24th of October. Councilmember Curtis Cook said he thought it would be good for the Mayor to go.

The amendment to the Animal ordinance was read and a motion was made to accept the amendment with the spelling and grammar corrections. All voted in favor

Colleen Dudleston was appointed to be the Liaison for the Community Covenant.

A motion was made to adjourn meeting by Janet Hansen and it was seconded by Curtis Cook. All were in favor and the meeting was adjourned at 6:40.
