

**Torrey Town Minutes**  
**Regular Meeting held February 9 2011**

**Welcome:** Mayor Adus Dorsey welcomed and called the meeting to order at 6:00 pm. The mayor stated that the meeting was a regularly scheduled meeting. A motion to approve the minutes as corrected of the January 13, 2011 meeting was made by Jen Howe and seconded by Curtis Cook. All council members voted in favor.

The financial report was presented by Colleen Dudleston. The bills were approved. The town agreed to give a \$1000.00 to Big Apple Days. Colleen reported the town has taken 280.00 from the sale of dog licenses.

It was also discussed as to whether the town should provide copying and faxing to the public. The council declined to do so. It was also discuss if we should offer businessess the opportunity to be connected to the town website. It was decided to have it be an option for the business at the time they renewed their licenses.

**Maintenance Report:** Chad Williams. The Rural Water helped the town install the PRV valve. The town will have to eventually purchase a new PRV valve and a new pressure reducer.

Mayor Adus Dorsey reported the Storage Container was placed at the cemetery. This will house part of the town equipment and water supplies. The price for the container was 2500 plus a 400.00 to move the container to Torrey. Peter Daniels suggested that we hire a scenic artist to paint the storage container.

**Park: Janet Hansen** Janet Colleen and Paula completed writing a grant for \$9500.00 for the Torrey Town playground equipment. We hope to have answer within the next couple of months. The town received a grant from the Special Services District for 5000.00. This will be used for the volley ball court. Janet said we will need volunteers for help Chad with the excavation, and installation of the playground equipment. Janet would like to write an article asking for volunteers.

**Mayor Report:** Mayor Dorsey suggested to Curtis that he would like to see Main Street kept as clean as possible. This is the first thing people see and the Mayor would like everyone to make the effort to work toward this end.

Marcie DeMillian bike path rep. Adus said he would write two letters to her concerning the bike path and money that was available.

Mayor Dorsey said he found Local Officials day to very informative, and was able to speak with people from other towns and organizations.

Sand Creek shares: The town will rent them out in the same way as they did as they did last year

The town will assist Sand creek in any way that they might need help.

Jen attended the January meeting held by the Planning and Zoning committee. The next meeting will be held on Feb 10. Jen will attend and from now on the P&Z meetings will be held prior to the town meeting so they can report to the town council. Jen said they will be sub committees of general planning and annexation.

Some people did not understand the Green Belt so information will be gathered on that. Annexation was discussed with the question being asked by Janet as to how it will affect taxes for the town. It was suggested that a package be compiled for the council including the how annexation will affect the roads, taxes and any other important information. It was also requested that a list of P&Z members be given to the council members.

One complaint was that there were more people that lived outside of town than inside serving on the PZ committee. Jen explained that the ordinance does not state only town residents could serve. There is one more opening and anyone wanting to sever on is welcomed.

Old Business: None

New Business: Glenn Furrows water was discussed. Several options were presented including one by Curtis Cook to refund his money and let him reapply at a later date.

Jen ask the board for money for mailings for the PZ committee. This would be used for stamps, envelopes, and copying. They will submit all invoices.

Peter Daniels as if the council has definitely decided to pursue annexation. The council said yes.

A motion was made to adjourn the meeting by council member Jen and councilmember Jamie seconded it. All council members were in favor.
