

TORREY TOWN ORDINANCE
2002-10/10/02

AN ORDINANCE REGULATING THE OPERATIN OF
OFF-HIGHWAY VEHICLES WITHIN TOWN BUONDARIES

Preamble: The Town council believes that the use of off-highway vehicles on the streets of Torrey needs to be regulated.

BE IT ORDAINED by the Torrey Town Council as follows:

Section 1: The ordinance applies to all streets and highways within the corporate limits of Torrey Town.

Section 2: Pursuant to Section 41-22-10.3 of the Utah Code annotated, as amended, all streets and highways in Torrey Town are hereby designated as open to off-highway vehicle use, except Highway 24.

Section 3: Persons using off-highway vehicles in Torrey Town must comply with all other restrictions set out in Title 41, Chapter 22, including but not limited to registration, compliance with traffic laws, vehicle equipment, protective gear, licensing, etc.

Section 4: No 2 stroke, 2 wheel bikes are allowed in Torrey Town limits. The speed limit for all off-highway vehicles is 15 MPH. All off-highway vehicles must ride on oil only- not on the frontage of private property. No more than two persons can ride on one vehicle.

Section 5: Any vioaltin of this ordinance will be a Class C Misdemeanor.

Section 6: This ordinance shall take effect on the date of its being posted.

PASSED AND APPROVED by the Torrey Town Council on October 10, 2002.
